
ELIGIBILITY:

 - ✓ Able to submit the paper in English, or with an accompanying English translation

SCOR's Actuarial Awards have been rewarding actuarial research for more than 25 years. In 2024, SCOR is partnering with the IFoA Foundation to launch new Actuarial Awards in Asia Pacific.

These prizes will promote the development of actuarial science, encourage research in this field, and contribute to the improvement of risk knowledge and management.

Rewarding and celebrating excellence in actuarial science is a core objective of the IFoA Foundation, whose mission is to give support and opportunities to actuaries and future actuaries from all backgrounds.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- You must have studied or be studying actuarial science at university (at any level – Bachelors, Masters, PhD). The research paper or thesis you submit should have been prepared as part of your studies.
- You must be graduating your programme in 2023, 2024, or 2025.
- Your university must be located in one of the locations in APAC where SCOR has an office: Singapore, Malaysia, Mainland China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Australia.
- The paper must be submitted in English, or with an accompanying English translation.
- Joint submissions are allowed where the paper has multiple authors, but each author must meet the criteria,

consent to the submission, and the prize money will be split equally.

- SCOR may publish the winning papers on its website.
- Employees of SCOR are excluded.

ENTRY PROCESS

- Entrants must submit their paper to ActuarialAwardsAPAC@scor.com by 1 July.
- They must include in the body of the email their name, university, course, and graduation date.

JUDGING PROCESS

The judging panel will comprise actuarial experts from both SCOR and the IFoA Foundation, winners will be contacted by 30 September.

AWARDS

The first place winner will receive SGD 5000 (or local currency equivalent) and a certificate of achievement. A presentation will be made in person, by a senior SCOR representative (depending on location).

The second place winner will receive SGD 3000 (or local currently equivalent) and a certificate of achievement.

The winning papers will be published on the SCOR website and the winners celebrated through SCOR and the IFoA Foundation's online channels, as well as in the Actuary Magazine. The awards will be administered by the IFoA Foundation, on behalf of SCOR.
